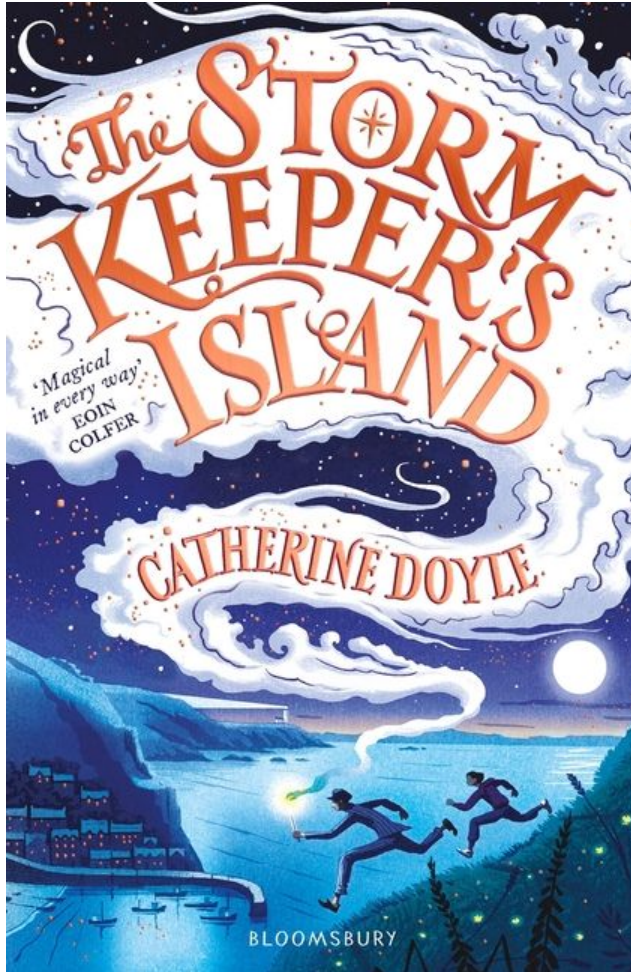


Lovereading4kids Reader reviews of The Storm Keeper's Island Written by Catherine Doyle
