

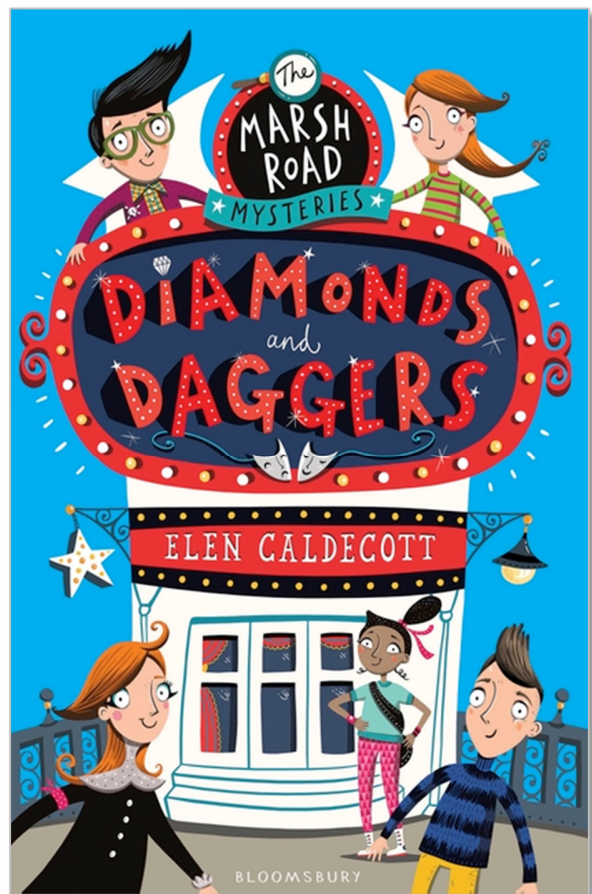
LoveReading4kids Reader reviews of The Marsh Road Mysteries: Diamonds and Daggers By Elen Caldecott
