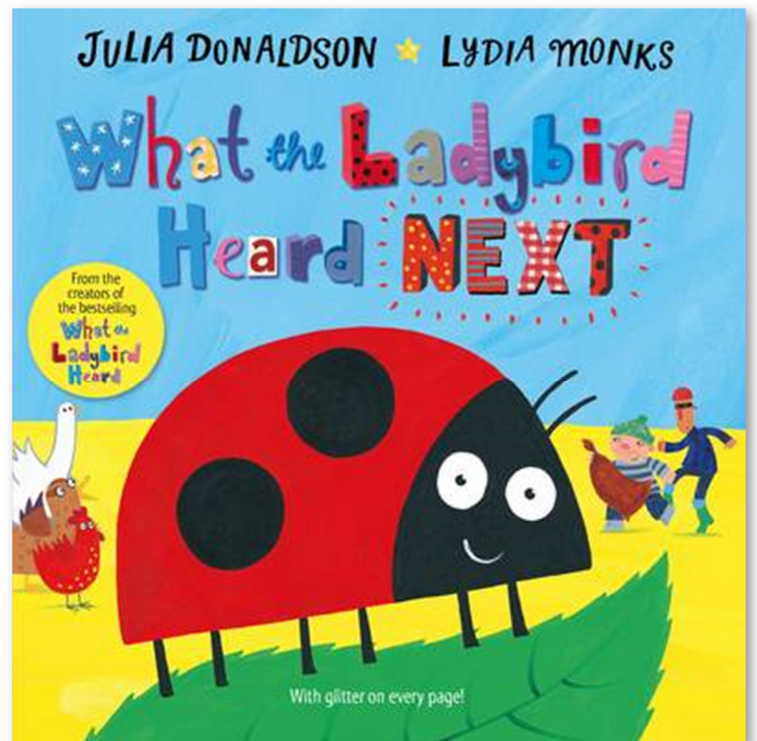
LoveReading4kids Reader reviews of **What the Ladybird Heard Next** by Julia Donaldson and Illustrated by Lydia Monks
